This is a Full-Time, Salaried/Exempt Position - Schedule: 37.5 hours a week, in person, with one evening a week, and weekend availability. This individual reports to our Youth Services Manager.

We are looking for a dynamic Youth Services Programming Librarian who will be responsible for developing, implementing, and promoting a wide range of educational and recreational programs for infants through middle school. This role requires creativity, enthusiasm, and a strong commitment to serving the needs of our young patrons.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

- Develops and implements a comprehensive programming schedule for children ages birth through middle school and their families in collaboration with other youth staff.
- Collaborates with library staff, community partners, and local schools to deliver a wide variety of programs that promote literacy, STEAM education, digital literacy, and creative expression.
- Creates and leads interactive and hands-on activities for youth and their families; guides other staff in the development of original programs.
- Researches, contacts, and negotiates with outside program presenters.

EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE:

- Master's degree from accredited library school; AND three (3) years of experience working with children in a library or educational setting.

SALARY: \$45,903 minimum - \$61,204 midpoint - \$76,505 maximum; offers are generally made within the minimum to the midpoint range depending on qualifications, experience, and internal equity.
